Community HealthCorps is a national AmeriCorps program where interns work to increase access to health and assist in eliminating health disparities. During their year of service interns receive a living stipend, benefits and an education award upon completion of service (depending on the length of service and hours worked).

Requirements:

- U.S. citizen, U.S. national or lawful permanent resident
- High School diploma required.
- Complete 1700 hours of work in a 11 month period
- Available starting September 15, 2009
- Commitment to AmeriCorps service
- Respect for and interest in working in medically underserved communities
- Exceptional people skills
- Ability to learn quickly
- Ability to multi-task and meet deadlines
- Good verbal and communication skills
- Proficiency in Spanish, Punjabi or Hmong a plus (not required)

- Monthly stipend (approx. \$1050/mo)
- Educational award (\$4,725 upon completion of service)
